LILY'S UNSTOPPABLE TEAM

Even before coming to Elim, Lily's parents enrolled her in physical therapy to help her build physical strength. When she joined Elim's family, she began working with Elim's physical therapy team. At that time, Lily was unable to stand, instead traveling through her daily tasks in a Rifton activity chair.

Elim's team first helped Lily build enough strength to stand using an assisted stander. Next, they worked with her and paired her with a walker to assist her in gaining walking skills. Now, she loves being able to run!

While Lily's walking skills are amazing, she's grown in other ways, too. Now seven years old, Lily has been paired with a communication device to help her express her wants and needs. Her improved communication skills have allowed Lily's personality to shine.

"Lily is the most joyful little girl I have ever met," says her teacher, Emily Paluch. "She's rarely upset and is always giggling and making us laugh. She has grown a lot socially since she started at Elim and now engages with her classmates during the school day."

Currently, Lily is learning to express her likes and dislikes, being encouraged to explain WHY she doesn't like something by using her device. She is also learning to identify shapes and colors. Her family is thrilled about all of Lily's new skills!

Elim's swimming program provides so many benefits to its participants. Not only does swimming bring physical benefits, but it also helps with coordination, flexibility, socialization, relaxation, sensory stimulation, and so much more!

That's why Elim's team knew they needed to get creative in order to get Michael swimming.

Michael is extremely social, remembers everyone's names, loves interacting with his peers, and delights in cracking jokes to Elim's staff members. Yet, even with his outgoing personality, Michael struggles with loud noises and with participating in recreational activities. And until now, he flat-out refused to swim.

Michael's teacher, Lauren Surbaugh, worked closely with his mom in order to brainstorm ways to get Michael in the pool. They came up with a strategy where Michael would be rewarded with his favorite toys from home if he was willing to join his classmates in pool time.

It worked! Now, Michael loves swimming with his friends on Fridays and anticipates the activity all week long. When in the pool, he works with an Elim recreational therapist to complete group activities like passing a ball, playing with water buckets, and finding rings on the bottom of the pool.

Not only is Michael now able to enjoy new social and educational activities in Elim's pool, he is also benefitting from the therapeutic effects of water activities. "It's very soothing and calming for Michael to be in the pool," Surbaugh explains. "It provides him with so many health and sensory benefits, too."
